| Pale straw colour, with a light green hue. On the nose, aromas of lime sherbet, citrus, ripe pear and a hint of gooseberry come forward. On the palate, tropical fruit notes lead to a crisp, lively acidity. | | | | |

| Ripe pear and spice on the nose follow through on to the palate in this beautifully refreshing crisp dry white. | | | | |

16. Italy	Nero d'Avola, Il Folle			£20.5
The grapes are hand harvested from the hills surrounding the town of Marsala in Sicily. Nero d'Avola is a pure full-bodied wine that has gorgeous aromatics of blackberry, cherry and vanilla. The king of Sicilian grapes.				
17. France	Malbec, Hornhead	£5.90	£8.10	£22.7
A deep dark red. Beautiful flavours of dark fruits, amplified with hints of coffee, cocoa and subtle rosemary. Wonderfully harmonic with a round and juicy mouthfeel.

The grapes come from old vines grown on a soil mix which gives the wine the typical steely and flinty edge which Chablis is so famous for.				
25. France	Hubert Brochard Sancerre Blanc 2019			£46
Domaine Hubert Brochard Sancerre Les Collines Blanches has fresh and fragrant Sauvignon Blanc fruit with overtones of gooseberries and a bright, refreshing acidity. First class Sancerre.				
26. Argentina	Zuccardi Chardonnay Apelacion 2018			£45
The grapes from the Tupungato vineyards in the Uco Valley offer minerality, great character and balance to the final blend. This wine is full of citrus fruits and vanilla notes.

27. France	Chateau La Fleur Des Graves , Graves des Vayres Rouge 2016			£39
Low yields, stainless steel fermentation and a year's maturation in French oak make for a harmonious, well-rounded claret with real personality and pretty aromatics.				
28. Italy	Allegrini Valpolicella 2019			£41
This Valpolicella is ruby red in colour, with youthful highlights. Fragrant fruit with prominent notes of dark cherries are echoed by fresher hints of pepper and aromatic herbs. This Valpolicella is impressively lively and playful on the palate, whilst exhibiting delicacy and finesse at the same time.				
29. Italy	Argiano Rosso di Montalcino 2019			£46
Rosso di Montalcino, made with 100% Sangiovese grapes like Brunello, is another expression of the tradition and terroir of Montalcino. This wine receives the same care and attention devoted to their Brunello. Deep ruby red in colour, it is medium bodied with tempting flavours of red berries, violets, menthol and earthiness. A generous wine with smooth, velvety tannins that will satisfy all Sangiovese lovers.
