2. Italu Prosecco Rose NV Biscardo £27 A brilliant rosé colour, the bouquet of elegant wild strawberry and cherry lead onto the smooth and harmonic palate. Vegan Friendly.

3. South Africa Graham Beck Cap Classique Brut NV (Traditional Method) £35 The wine is characterised by light, yeasty aromas, a rich and creamy complexity, with the fine mousse giving it freshness and finesse.

4. France Champagne Gallimard brut NV Cuvee reserve £57 An attractive fruity nose, with aromas of exotic fruit. In the mouth, it is supple and very well-balanced. The mousse is fine and long lasting.

20 cl Bottle 5. Italu Le Contesse Prosecco Extra Dry 20cl £8.5 Sparkling wine obtained from an exclusive selection of grapes from Treviso plains area. It is a light straw yellow colour with a fine perlage. Fruitful and typical nose. Soft and lightly aromatic taste.

6. South Africa Chenin Blanc, Stormy Cape £4.90 £6.40 £18.7 Pale in colour with an enticingly citrus nose, this is a typically racy South African Chenin with a good concentration of sub-tropical fruit well balanced with fresh citrus acidity and a dry finish.

7. France F21 Viognier, Mont Roche Pale straw colour, with a light green hue. On the nose, aromas of lime sherbet, citrus, ripe pear and a hint of gooseberry come forward. On the palate, tropical fruit notes lead to a crisp, lively acidity.

11. France Maçon Lugny, Les Charmes £35.5 The most famous and still probably the best Macon Lugny. Produced exclusively from the Chardonnay grape, the 'Les Charmes' vineyard produces a top quality white Burgundy. Full-flavoured, fruity and dry.
